SANTA FE SOUTHERN PACIFIC CORPORATION - CONTROL -SOUTHERN PACIFIC TRANSPORTATION COMPANY

Decided: April 15, 1987

Applicants have filed a petition and supplemental petition to reopen, and parties have filed responsive comments. Oral argument, restricted to the question of whether this proceeding should be reopened, is set for Thursday, May 14 at 9:30 a.m. in Hearing Room A at the Interstate Commerce Commission, Washington, DC.

Parties who wish to participate in oral argument must indicate whether they support or oppose the petition and how much time they seek to speak. The parties shall notify the Commission of the names of their speakers and the amount of time requested for each. Parties must inform Ellen Goldstein, Room 2131, telephone (202) 275-7969, by close of business April 27, 1987. We will then issue a schedule of appearances for the oral argument and specify any issues the parties should be prepared to address. The time for presentation will be divided equally betweeen proponents and opponents, with each side receiving one hour and fifteen minutes of time.

This action will not significantly affect either the quality of the human environment or energy conservation.

It is ordered:

1. Oral argument in this proceeding will be held Thursday, May 14, 1987.

2. Interested parties must inform the Commission that they want to participate in oral argument, as stated above.

3. This decision will be effective on the date served.
